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1 Introduction

1.1 Reporting population

Report S 2.8 must be provided by all resident credit institutions regardless of their legal status.

1.2 Frequency and reporting deadlines

Report S 2.8 must be provided to BCL on a monthly no later than 20 calendar days after the end of the reference period.

The exact reporting dates for report S 2.8 are published on the website of the BCL (<http://www.bcl.lu>).

2 Information to report

The following information on loans granted for buildings located in Luxembourg must be reported:

- report S 2.8 must provide information on all credits granted during the quarter for buildings located in Luxembourg
- a distinction must be made between debtors that are Luxembourg residents (category of credit 1) and/or non residents (catégorie de crédit 2).

For the purpose of this report residents shall mean physical persons residing in Luxembourg and corporations whose head office is located in Luxembourg.

- As far as concerns resident debtors (category of credit 1) a breakdown must be made according to residential sector (category of credit 11) and non residential sector (category of credit 12).

The residential sector regroups all the credits granted to finance buildings for housing whereas the non residential sector regroups all the credits granted to finance buildings for other purpose than housing.

- Only land and property constructions must be reported. Thus, credits granted for naval constructions must not be reported
