List of reporting Member States for the «AnaCredit» report

Reporting Member State, as defined by Article 1.1 of Regulation (EU) 2016/867 of the European central bank of 18 May 2016 on the collection of granular credit data and credit risk data (ECB/2016/13), means:

«a Member State whose currency is the euro; Member States whose currency is not the euro may decide to become a reporting Member State by incorporating the provisions of this Regulation into their national law or otherwise imposing relevant reporting requirements in accordance with their national law; this may include, in particular, Member States that participate in the SSM via close cooperation in accordance with Article 7 of Council Regulation (EU) No 1024/2013¹».

At the moment, the list of reporting Member States comprises only the 19 euro area Member States, that is to say:
