Concerns: Foreign Direct Investment survey

Ladies and Gentlemen,

The Grand Ducal decree of 10 November 1944, modified by the law of 28 June 2000, assigns to the Banque centrale du Luxembourg (BCL) jointly with the Service Central de la Statistique et des Etudes Economiques (STATEC) the mission to establish the Balance of Payments statistics and the International Investment Position of Luxembourg. In addition, the aforementioned law stipulates that the STATEC is responsible for the Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) statistics. The BCL and the STATEC have decided that the BCL is in charge of collecting FDI data from all resident credit institutions and the Entreprise des Postes et Télécommunications.

The FDI survey applies to all resident credit institutions which have direct investment relationships with their investors abroad (inward FDI), or with their own non-resident affiliates or branches (outward FDI).

The questionnaires and instructions relating to the survey can be downloaded from the BCL's website (<u>www.bcl.lu</u>).

In case of discrepancies between the French text and the English text, the French text shall prevail.

The questionnaires, duly completed and signed, have to be returned to the BCL before: <u>17 June 2022</u>. Should your credit institution meet some problems to respect this deadline, you are requested to advise us before this date.
