**«Staff report - Luxembourg entity and
its branches»**

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1 Introduction

1.1 Reporting population

Report S 2.9-N must be provided by all resident credit institutions with branches abroad and includes data pertaining to the global business, that is to say the overall institution composed by the Luxembourg head office and its branches abroad.

1.2 Frequency and reporting deadlines

Report S 2.9-N must be provided to the BCL on a quarterly basis no later than 20 calendar days after the end of the reference period.

The BCL establishes and publishes, on its website, a calendar with the remittance dates for statistical reports.

2 Information to be provided

Report S 2.9-N «Staff report - Luxembourg entity and its branches» must contain the same information as required by report S 2.9-L «Staff report - Luxembourg entity».

Therefore, as regards the information to be provided for report S 2.9-N «Staff report - Luxembourg entity and its branches», reporting agents refer to the reporting instructions applicable to report S 2.9-L «Staff report - Luxembourg entity».

In this context, it is important to note that ~~unlike the report the S 2.9-L «Staff report - Luxembourg entity»~~ report S 2.9-N «Staff report - Luxembourg entity and its branches» must report in addition to the staff of the Luxembourg entity, also persons employed in a branch and / or an office abroad.
