

The Banque centrale du Luxembourg, on behalf of the Eurosystem, is looking for Members of the Design Selection Panel for future euro banknote

For the development of a new series of banknotes, the European Central Bank requests that all national central banks of the Eurosystem assist in the composition of the Design Selection Panel (DSP) for future euro banknotes. The DSP will be composed by experts with known and recognised high-level expertise in different fields (e.g. graphic and web designers, illustrators, artists, photographers, communication experts, architectural and industrial designers, professionals in digital art and graphic design, expert in arts). The group should also represent a wide range of demographic groups (in particular age and gender) and should be able to connect to the young generations.

The assessment of the competences will be based on the renown, international reputation, background and could be based on track records of international exhibitions, architecture prize or similar, number of projects or proven realizations, number of publications, internationally renowned artistic works (...).

The adequacy of the nominees will be evaluated based on the CVs received. The nominees must have a fluent level of English.

The Design Selection Panel (DSP) will:

- 1. Before the Design Competition
- Review and finalise the Design Brief in relation with D/BN
- Review and finalise the design selection criteria in relation with D/BN
- 2. During the Design Competition
- Respond to the questions from the participants in the design competition, in relation with D/BN
- 3. After the Design Competition
- Evaluate the designs from the participants, based on established criteria
- Prepare a short list of designs (5 or 6)
- Rank the designs
- Prepare a comprehensive report to support the final choice of the Governing Council

The meetings will be organised either remotely or physically depending on the circumstances. The BCL will enter into a contractual agreement with the final selected nominee to ensure inter alia the confidentiality of the information exchanged, the safeguard of the Eurosystem reputation and the avoidance of possible conflicts of interest of their nominees. Members of the Design Selection Panel are prohibited from entering / taking part in the design competition.

The adequacy of potential candidates will be assessed in a two-step-approach, based on their CVs, considering their international reputation in their professional field. In a first step, the Banque centrale du Luxembourg will pre-select suitable candidates from the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg. In a second step, the European Central Bank will select 19 to 20 experts for the DSP, ensuring that all euro area countries are represented.

The expected number of meetings / working days is between 12 and 20, considering the uncertainty on the number of designs to be evaluated, with additional preparatory and follow up work in between. The panel will be active mainly before (around 3 months) and after (again around 3 months) the design competition. The candidates should stand ready for this task throughout the whole process of around 1 year (from December 2022 to December 2023).

The Banque centrale du Luxembourg will conclude a contractual agreement with each selected candidate to ensure the confidentiality of the information exchanged, the safeguarding of the Eurosystem's reputation and the avoidance of possible conflicts of interest on the part of the candidates.

The travel and accommodation expenses of the selected expert will be borne by the BCL according to the BCL's internal rules.
